RESOLUTION NO. 2009-89

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA EXTENDING THE DESIGNATION OF THE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD OF FLAGLER AND VOLUSIA COUNTIES, INC. d/b/a CENTER FOR BUSINESS EXCELLENCE, AS THE GRANT RECIPIENT/ADMINISTRATOR, AND PROGRAM PLANNER FOR ALL PROGRAMS FUNDED UNDER THE WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT (29USC2832, PUBLIC LAW 105-220, SEC 117) FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS AND APPROVAL OF THE CURRENT MEMBERS OF THE BOARD.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has identified the need for a consolidated workforce development system and both the legislative and executive branches have adopted a uniform policy to guide education, training, and employment programs within the State; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Statutes; Chapter 445, designates Workforce Florida, Inc. as the principal workforce policy organization with the responsibility of planning and accountability for the State's workforce development strategy; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has identified the Interlocal Agreement as the method for establishment of the community board, also known as the Regional Workforce Board (RWB) in a multi-county area; and

WHEREAS, the Workforce Investment Act (WIA), herein referred to as the Act (29 USC 2732, Public Law 105-220, Section 117), authorizes the expenditure of federal funds for the job training programs within designated service delivery areas; and

WHEREAS, the counties of Flagler and Volusia constitute a designated region under the Act and a region for workforce development activities under the Workforce Florida Act of 1998; and


WHEREAS, Section 163.01 of the Florida Statutes permit local governmental units to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate on a basis of mutual advantage under the Florida Interlocal Act of 1969; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2008, the County Council of Volusia County, Florida approved an amendment to the Local Workforce Services Plan and extension of the designation for a period ending June 30, 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the Workforce Development Board of Flagler and Volusia Counties, Inc. d/b/a Center for Business Excellence designation as the grant recipient/administrator, and program planner for all programs funded under the Workforce Investment Act (29 USC 2832, Public Law 105-220, Sec. 117) be extended until June 30, 2011 and the current members of the Board are approved.



**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
FOR THE CONTINUATION OF A REGIONAL WORKFORCE BOARD**

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has identified the need for a consolidated workforce development system and both the legislative and executive branches have adopted a uniform policy to guide education, training, and employment programs within the State; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Statutes; Chapter 445, designates Workforce Florida, Inc. as the principal workforce policy organization with the responsibility of planning and accountability for the State's workforce development strategy; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has identified the Interlocal Agreement as the method for establishment of the community board, also known as the Regional Workforce Board (RWB) in a multi-county area; and

WHEREAS, the Workforce Investment Act (WIA), herein referred to as the Act (29 USC 2732, Public Law 105-220, Section 117), authorizes the expenditure of federal funds for the job training programs within designated service delivery areas; and


WHEREAS, the State of Florida has identified the Regional Workforce Boards as the local entities to implement the policy which guides the education, training and employment programs.

NOW, therefore, be it resolved that the local elected officials of Flagler and Volusia Counties acknowledge the need for maximization of education, training and employment resources and the need for a local workforce development board charged with the responsibility for implementing federal and state policies at the local level. The local elected officials hereby express their desire to continue this agreement for a workforce development board. We, the undersigned, do hereby designate the Workforce Development Board of Flagler and Volusia Counties, Inc., d.b.a. Center for Business Excellence as the local Workforce Development Board, fiscal agent, administrative and operational entity, for workforce development activities within the counties of Flagler and Volusia. The Board, hereinafter referred to as the Workforce Development Board of Flagler and Volusia Counties, Inc. d.b.a. Center for Business Excellence, shall serve as the community board under Workforce Florida, Inc., the Workforce Investment Board under the Act, and be the local entity that guides the education, training, and employment programs within the two-county area.

The local elected officials wish to state their desire for the two-county area to receive Workforce Investment Act funds and to that end, it is hereby resolved that we, the undersigned, do hereby designate the Workforce Development Board of Flagler and Volusia Counties, Inc. d.b.a. Center for Business Excellence as the grant recipient/administrator, and program planner for all programs funded under the Workforce Investment Act (29 USC 2832, Public Law 105-220, Sec 117) with all the responsibilities and liabilities associated therewith.

- I. The Workforce Development Board of Flagler and Volusia Counties, Inc. d.b.a. Center for Business Excellence shall be composed of representatives of the two counties.
- II. The Workforce Development Board of Flagler and Volusia Counties, Inc. d.b.a. Center for Business Excellence shall be composed of a minimum of 30 representatives with a minimum of three representatives from Flagler County. Membership may be expanded to comply with legislative changes.
- III. Each county shall appoint representatives to the Board in accordance with criteria established by the State Workforce Board and Section 117 of the Workforce Investment Act.
- IV. Each county shall have one representative of county government. These representatives shall be either the Chairs of the County Council/Commission or their designee, who shall be an elected County Councilman/Commissioner.
- V. The majority of the appointed representatives shall consist of members of the private sector as defined in Section 117 of the Workforce Investment Act and criteria established by Florida State Statutes and Workforce Florida Inc.; the State's designated workforce investment board.
- VI. This agreement shall be effective immediately and shall remain in effect until June 30, 2011.
